Entry fee is \$125 if paid prior to November 1st, \$175 after November 1st

Rules & Regulations

- 1 Contestants must be at least 21 years of age and be able to verify with proper identification.
- 2 Judging will be on a total accumulated scoring system.
- 3 Contestants will be judged in the categories Members Interview, Presentation (coldest winter ever), Talent, evening gown, Speak On It Q&A
- 4 All contestants must compete in each category
- 6 There are no geographical location requirements in order to compete. Contestants are welcome from all over.
- 7 All talent presentations are limited to five (7) minutes in length. No score will be given to any contestant whose talent runs over the allotted time. All talent presentations must be on a high quality thumb drive. **No mini-discs, cassettes, 8-tracks, records, Ipods or MP3 Players are allowed.** You may also email your music.

There is a three (3) minute prop set-up time that is not included in the five minutes allotted for the talent portion of the competition

- 8- Any type of talent presentation is acceptable and welcome except water, fire, Confetti Canons or any act that may be dangerous to the other contestants or the audience.
- 9 Any contestant or anyone affiliated with a contestant caught in the act of stealing or vandalism will be immediately disqualified.

10- Miss Sawmill will receive:

a.\$600 the night of Miss Sawmill.

b.\$300.00 at Stepdown

c.\$125 a week in bookings (Most Miss Sawmills have made over \$10,000 during their reign) if you cannot work every week \$150 6 bookings a year

d.\$150 when the official promo is submitted

- f. 4 weekends in a premium cabin at Sawmill Resort on a non –holiday weekend (\$1200.00 value)
 - g. Sawmill Caribbean Cruise during reign minus port fees and taxes
 - h. and other prizes

Dressing Room Policies

- 1 Each Contestant is allowed one (1) assistant at any one time in the dressing room area.
- 2 Although smoking and drinking is allowed in the dressing room area, please be extra careful not to spill or set fire to anything.
- 3 Dancer(s) involved with a contestant for their talent presentation may enter the dressing room area when there are two (2) numbers remaining before them. (I.E., when contestant #3 is performing, contestant #5's dancers may enter the dressing room area. After the dancers have completed their number, they must leave the dressing room area as quick as possible.
